1. Apologies for absence

2. Minutes of the Previous Meeting held on 11th August 2015

3. Strategic Aims

An updated report was received and noted. The following updates were agreed and noted:

4. Environmental Visual Audit (EVA) 22nd December 2015

An updated document was received and noted. It was noted that more litter bins were needed at the station. A new card only ticket machine would be installed by Spring 2016. British Transport Police were now making regular visits to the station to help deter antisocial behaviour.

It was requested that the current financial figure for clearing litter at the station be requested from South Eastern and be made public via the noticeboard at the station.

5. Visit to Etchingham Station 7th September 2015

An update was received from the Town Clerk. It was felt that the building was very impressive with a nice café area and garden to the rear. The building now acted as a community hub with lots of social events taking place during the evenings. Some ideas from the visit would be taken forward to use in future projects at Bat & Ball Station.

6. Bat & Ball Station Building

An updates was received from the Town Clerk. The structural survey had now been received with negotiations to start shortly regarding the management and lease to Sevenoaks Town Council from the current owners. Funding for the project would need to be sought.

7. Finance Report

8. Frequency and dates for future meetings
