
Double Decker Bus Template

Step by Step



Cut around the outside of the suitcase


Cut along these red dash lines

Fold along these grey dash lines

1. Cut around the outside of your bus

There are some areas with a yellow

dotted line which needs cutting



Fold along the grey dotted lines. It's easier to fold with the bus facing us, and then reverse fold then with the bus facing down. Use a ruler to help keep the folds straight and smooth.



Begin to glue- start with the back end of the bus.



The back step of the bus goes inward.



The inside window where the driver looks out of also goes inward



6. To finish, put the base of the bus to hold it all together and make a rectangle shape! All done!
