GOVIA THAMESLINK RAILWAY PASSENGER FUND

GTR are contributing £15 million towards a passenger benefit fund which can be used to provide tangible benefits for passengers. EXHIBITION & TALK- Restoration Station - The renaissance of Bat & Ball 2018-2019





The last weekend in June Derek Medhurst and Roger Lee from Sevenoaks Camera Club hosted an exhibition featuring some of the more unusual images taken during the Station refurbishment. Despite the heatwave they had over 120 attendees, many of whom also enjoyed the facilities in the Café at the Station. On Tuesday 2nd July they delivered an equally successful talk to over 50 attendees, about the processes of recording the restoration of the station and some of the issues and challenges they faced.
